INFORMATION NOTE

RE : Evolution of the measures taken by the government to avoid the introduction of Covid 19 (Coronavirus) in French Polynesia.

Following the information note of 26 February 2020, a medical certificate not older than 5 days certifying that the traveller's health condition is free of any signs of coronavirus infection, was required before boarding a flight bound for French Polynesia, for any traveller who has stayed, within 30 days prior to travel, in a risk area listed on the French Polynesian Health Directorate website.

As the virus is spreading across the world, this measure is evolving.

As from 02 March 2020, any person (including flight crews), when boarding a flight bound for French Polynesia, is required to present a medical certificate stating that his/her health condition is free of any signs of coronavirus infection.
