### **BUSINESS FLIGHT RESTRICTIONS**

- Cape Verde Airports are open to all inbound international flights
- Negative Covid PCR test is required for all passengers and crew that are disembarking, not older than 72 hrs.
- Test can be performed at the airport on arrival at the persons expense.
- Prior permission required

### **RESTRICTIONS FOR TECHNICAL REFUELING/CREW REST**

- Tech Stops are authorized

### **QUARANTINE REQUIREMENTS**

- Crew members authorized to disembark shall comply with Sanitary and Health Screening procedures

### **DATE THE RESTRICTION IS CURRENTLY EXPECTED TO END OR BE RE-EVALUATED**

E) COVID-19: ALL INBOUND INTL FLIGHTS, TO AND FROM CABO VERDE, ARE AUTHORIZED.

OPERATIONS ARE ALSO AUTHORIZED FOR TECHNICAL LANDING AND REFUELING AT NATIONAL AIRPORTS THAT MAY INVOLVE THE REST OF CREWS AND PASSENGERS, AND THE RESPECTIVE EMBARKATION AND DISEMBARKATION OF PASSENGERS AND CREW MEMBERS

HEALTH SURVEILLANCE

CREW MEMBERS AND PASSENGERS INTENDING TO DISEMBARK, ARE REQUIRED TO PRESENT A NEGATIVE ANTIGEN TEST RESULT OR A NEGATIVE RT-PCR TEST RESULT, OR ANY OTHER NEGATIVE MOLECULAR TEST RESULT VALIDATED BY HEALTH AUTHORITIES, CARRIED OUT WITHIN A MAXIMUM PERIOD OF 72 HOURS, BEFORE BOARDING, UNDER PENALTY OF BEING REFUSED ENTRY INTO THE COUNTRY.

THE TEST IS ALLOWED TO BE PERFORMED IN CABO VERDE AT THE PASSENGER'S EXPENSE. IT IS INCUMBENT ON OPERATORS AND AIRPORT AND HEALTH AUTHORITIES, BEFORE BOARDING, TO REQUEST PASSENGERS TO PRESENT THE NEGATIVE ANTIGEN TEST RESULT, THE NEGATIVE RT-PCR TEST RESULT OR ANY OTHER NEGATIVE MOLECULAR TEST RESULT, CARRIED OUT WITHIN A MAXIMUM PERIOD OF 72 HOURS, AND IN CASE OF NON-COMPLIANCE, IT IS FORBIDDEN TO BE BOARDING OR DISEMBARKING, AS THE CASE MAY BE.

CREW AND PASSENGERS MUST COMPLETE THE SURVEILLANCE AND HEALTH CONTROL FORM, PREFERABLY VIA THE WEB, WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO BEING ABLE TO DO IT ON BOARD UPON AVAILABILITY BY THE AIR OPERATOR.

PEOPLE ARRIVING IN CABO VERDE MUST UNDERGO A HEALTH SCREENING AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE TERMINAL AND WHEN A FEVER IS DETECTED, THEY MUST BE IMMEDIATELY TAKEN TO THE ISOLATION SPACE WHERE THEY WILL BE SUBJECTED TO A SECOND FEVER SCREENING, WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO OTHER LEGAL HEALTH MEASURES IMPOSED. IF THE SITUATION ASSESSMENT JUSTIFIES IT, THEY MUST BE SUBJECTED TO AN ANTIGEN TEST OR A RT-PCR TEST OR ANY OTHER MOLECULAR TEST VALIDATED BY COVID-19, BY THE COMPETENT ENTITIES.

EXCEPTIONAL REGIME

1. PASSENGERS WHO, EXCEPTIONALLY, DO NOT CARRY PROOF OF TESTING TO COVID-19, WITH A NEGATIVE RESULT, UNDER THE TERMS OF THE PREVIOUS NUMBERS, ARE IMMEDIATELY REFERRED BY THE COMPETENT SECURITY AUTHORITIES, TO CARRY OUT THE SAID TEST, AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE.

2. THE CREW OF OPERATORS WHO CARRY OUT REGULAR COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES, DULY AUTHORIZED BY THE AIR AUTHORITIES, ARE EXEMPT FROM THE PRESENTATION OF AN ANTIGEN TEST, AN RT-PCR TEST OR ANY OTHER

VALIDATED MOLECULAR TEST WITH A NEGATIVE RESULT, CARRIED OUT WITHIN A MAXIMUM PERIOD OF 72 HOURS, WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO COMPLIANCE WITH THE OTHER MEASURES DETERMINED BY HEALTH AUTHORITIES.

3. PASSENGERS IN TRANSIT OR IN TRANSFER, WHO DO NOT CROSS THE NATIONAL BORDER, ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE PRESENTATION OF THE ANTIGEN TEST, THE RT-PCR TEST OR ANY OTHER MOLECULAR TEST, WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO THE OBSERVANCE OF THE OTHER MEASURES DETERMINED BY THE HEALTH AUTHORITIES.

4. CHILDREN UNDER 7 YEARS OF AGE ARE EXCLUDED FROM THE PRESENTATION OF THE ANTIGEN TEST, THE RT-PCR TEST OR ANY OTHER MOLECULAR TEST
