

Foreign Operator Permit Application Documents

- Designation Note of Letter issued by the Government designating the airline (likely to be required for scheduled service only).
- Air Operator Certificate (including the extract from the Ops Specs which indicate the geographical areas for which the Certificate is valid).
- Certificate of Insurance
- Certificate of Airworthiness
- Aircraft Registration Certificate
- Aircraft Noise Certificate
- A statement that there are no Dangerous Goods, weapons or munitions of war being carried on the flights
- A statement from the operator's Flight Operations Department that the airline is aware of the requirements of Article 76 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2007 (Aerodrome Operating Minima)
- If the aircraft is or are wet or dry leased, the following is required:
Contact details (name, address, telephone, fax, telex) of the lessor airline
Copy of the lease agreement along with confirmation from the lessor airline of which of the airlines operations and flight manuals will be used (so that it is known for legal purposes which airline will be the operator of the aircraft)
- A statement that the aircraft are fitted with appropriate ground proximity warning systems (GPWS)
- A statement that the aircraft are fitted with airborne collision avoidance system (ACAS) II version 7.
- A statement that the aircraft comply with the FM immunity requirements in paragraph 3.1.4 of Vol. 1 of Annex 10 to the Chicago Convention.
