

**CERTIFICATE OF TRAVEL TO METROPOLITAN FRANCE FROM A COUNTRY IDENTIFIED AS A
CIRCULATION ZONE* OF COVID-19 INFECTION**

(***ALL COUNTRIES EXCEPTED** THE MEMBER STATES OF THE EUROPEAN UNION, ANDORRA, ICELAND,
LIECHTENSTEIN, MONACO, NORWAY, SAN MARINO, VATICAN, AUSTRALIA, SOUTH KOREA, ISRAEL, JAPAN, NEW
ZEALAND, UNITED KINGDOM, SINGAPORE)

This certificate must be presented to the transport companies, before boarding, by passengers wishing to travel to metropolitan France, as well as to the authorities in charge of border control. Failure to do so will result in a refusal of boarding or access to the territory. It must be accompanied by the presentation of :

- A declaration on honour attesting to the absence of symptoms of covid-19 infection and of contact with a confirmed case of covid-19;
- An undertaking on honour to undergo an antigen test or biological examination on arrival;
- An undertaking on honour to isolate oneself for seven days, if necessary in one of the places designated by the French authorities, and an undertaking on honour to undergo a biological virological screening test (PCR) at the end of the isolation period.
- For persons aged 11 years or over, a biological virological screening test (PCR) carried out less than 72 hours before boarding that does not conclude to a covid-19 contamination;

I certify that my reason for travelling is one of the following compelling reasons (tick box) :

1. French nationals, their spouse (married, civil union and cohabiting) and their children;

2. A European Union or assimilated national, as well as his/her spouse (married, civil partner and cohabiting partner) and children, who has his/her main residence in France or who joins, in transit through France, his/her main residence in a European Union or assimilated country or the country of his/her nationality;

3. Third-country national holding a valid French or European long-stay visa or residence permit, whose main residence is in France or who is in transit through France to his or her main residence in a European Union or similar country (valid only if the move abroad took place before 31 January 2021 or was justified by a compelling reason);

4. British nationals and their family members who are beneficiaries of the Agreement on the Withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community; (valid only if the trip abroad took place before 31 January 2021 or was justified by a compelling reason);

5. Third-country nationals holding a long-stay visa issued for family reunification or family reunification of refugees, beneficiaries of subsidiary protection and stateless persons;

6. Foreign health or research professional involved in the fight against Covid-19 or recruited as an associate trainee;

[] 7. Third-country nationals with a VLS "*Passport Talent*";

[] 8. Student moving to France for the second university semester as part of a higher education institution's programme; Researcher moving to France at the invitation of a research laboratory, for research activities requiring a physical presence;

[] 9. Workers in the land, sea and air transport sector or providers of transport services, including drivers of any vehicle carrying goods for use in the territory as well as those who are merely transiting, or travelling as a passenger to position themselves at their home base or for training;

[] 10. Foreign nationals working for a diplomatic or consular mission or an international organisation with a headquarters or office in France, as well as their spouse and children, or foreign nationals from third countries staying in France for imperative professional reasons under cover of a mission order issued by the State to which they belong;

[] 11. Traveller in transit for less than 24 hours in an international zone.
