Subject: Latest Country Restrictions through July 1, 2021

### OPEN WITH RESTRICTIONS

US aircraft: Allowed to enter

US passenger: Allowed to enter for essential travel only

Quarantine: No – PCR 48h / vaccination certificate / recovery certificate required.

## BUSINESS FLIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Carriers are prohibited to transport passengers into Germany from the Areas of the Variant of Concern.

The transport ban doesn't apply to:

- German citizens and their close family; notification to Federal Police 3 days prior flight
- German residents; notification to Federal Police 3 days prior flight
- Transit passengers
- Cargo/mail/ferry flights
- Repatriation of aircrafts and crews
- Transportation of personnel in the interest of public health
- Ambulance flights and transportation of transplant organs
- Flights for urgent humanitarian reasons
- Flights on behalf of the EURATOM safeguards, UN and its agencies or International Atomic Energy Agency
- Members of foreign diplomatic mission or consular office

Travel restrictions apply to all non-essential travel from all Non-EU/Schengen countries.

Exempted from the restrictions are:

- German citizens
- Residents of the following Third Countries: AUSTRALIA, ISRAEL, JAPAN, NEW ZEALAND, SINGAPORE, THAILAND, SOUTH KOREA.

Travelers from other countries with an **imperative need for travel** are given extended entry possibilities under the following travel categories:

- EU citizens



- Third Country nationals with a permanent residence in Germany
- Healthcare workers, health researchers and geriatric care workers
- Skilled and highly qualified foreign workers if the work cannot be postponed or performed abroad
  - **Business travelers:** must provide sufficient evidence from the employer or business partner in Germany that their entry is absolutely necessary. A declaration of the absolute necessity of business travel is required. More information:

- Freight transport and other transport personnel
- Seasonal workers in agriculture
- Seafarers
- Foreign students, trainees, volunteers
- Persons immigrating into Germany for the purpose for joining their families and visits for urgent family reasons
- Staff of diplomatic missions & international organizations, humanitarian aid and military personnel on duty
- Passengers in transit

## RESTRICTIONS FOR TECHNICAL REFUELING/CREW REST

- Technical refueling is allowed
- Crew rest is allowed

## QUARANTINE REQUIREMENTS

Persons entering Germany by air must present - irrespective of whether or not they spent time in a risk area – a **negative covid test** result or **vaccination certificate** or a **certificate of recovery** from covid-19 to their carrier prior to departure.

Travelers having stayed in the **Areas of Variant of Concern** within the last 10 days prior entry are required to:

- Pre-register electronically at <https://www.einreiseanmeldung.de>

- Present prior boarding : a negative PCR test not older than 72 hours or rapid antigen test not older than 24 hours prior entry. *Vaccination certificate or proof of recovery from covid will not be accepted.*
- Above is mandatory for both crew and passengers.
- Self-isolate for 14 days.
- From June 11: *Botswana, Brazil, Eswatini, India, Lesotho, Malawi, Mozambique, Nepal, South Africa, United Kingdom incl. all British Overseas Territories, Isle of Man and the Channel Islands, Uruguay, Zambia, Zimbabwe*

Travelers having stayed in a **High-Incidence area** within the last 10 days prior entry are required to:

- Pre-register electronically at <https://www.einreiseanmeldung.de>
- Present prior boarding : a negative PCR test not older than 72 hours or rapid antigen test not older than 48 hours prior entry. Crew is exempted from PCR test if staying less than 72 hours in Germany.
- Self-isolate for 10 days
- From June 11: *Argentina, Bahrain, Bolivia, Cape Verde, Chile, Columbia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Egypt, Iran, Kuwait, Malaysia, Maldives, Mongolia, Namibia, Paraguay, Peru, Seychelles, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Surinam, Syria, Tanzania, Trinidad & Tobago, Tunisia*

Travelers having stayed in a **Basic Risk area** within the last 10 days prior entry are required to:

- Pre-register electronically at <https://www.einreiseanmeldung.de>
- Present prior boarding : a negative PCR test not older than 72 hours or rapid antigen test not older than 48 hours prior entry. Crew is exempted.
- Self-isolate for 10 days
- From June 11: *Afghanistan, Algeria, Andorra, Angola, Bahamas, Bangladesh, Belarus, Belgium, Belize, Benin, Bhutan, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Comoros, Cote d'Ivoire, Croatia, Cuba, Denmark (excl. Faroe Islands and Greenland), Djibouti, Dominican Republic, DR Congo, El Salvador, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Estonia, Ethiopia, France, Gabon, Gambia, Georgia, Ghana, Greece, Guatemala, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, Indonesia, Iraq, Ireland, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Korea, Kyrgyzstan, Latvia, Liberia, Libya, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Madagascar, Mali, Mauritania, Mexico, Morocco, Netherlands, Nicaragua, Niger, Nigeria, Norway, Oman, Pakistan, Palestinian territories, Panama, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Portugal, Qatar, Congo, Russian, Federaion, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Slovenia, Somalia, Spain, South Sudan, St Lucia, Sweden, Switzerland, Tajikistan, Timor Leste, Togo, Turkey, Turkmenistan, United Arab Emirates, Uzbekistan, Venezuela, Yemen.*



Travelers having stayed in a **No-Risk area** within the last 10 days prior entry:

- Prior boarding: Travelers must present a negative covid test result / **vaccination certificate** / a certificate of recovery from covid-19 to their carrier prior to departure.
- No quarantine requirements.
- From June 11, **USA & Canada** have been removed from the 'Risk area' category and can be considered as No-Risk area. All other countries not present in the categories above are considered no-risk areas.
- *Note: Entry into Germany remains restricted and is possible only in exceptional cases – travelers from Third Countries must still have an **essential travel reason** to enter Germany. This applies regardless of whether the traveler is fully vaccinated or not.*

**Quarantine:** People who have stayed in a **risk area** must go home immediately after arrival - or other accommodation at the destination - and isolate themselves for 10 days (home quarantine ). People who have previously stayed in a **virus variant area**, the quarantine period is 14 days.

**Ending the quarantine:** The domestic quarantine can be ended prematurely if proof of recovery, a vaccination certificate or a negative test certificate is submitted via the entry portal of the Federal Republic of Germany at <https://www.einreiseanmeldung.de> . The quarantine can be ended from the time of transmission. After a **previous** stay in **high-incidence areas** , a test can be carried out **no earlier than 5 days after entry** . After staying in **virus variant areas**, the **quarantine** lasts **14 days** and an early termination of the quarantine is not possible.

**Vaccination certificate:**

Proof of complete vaccination protection against the coronavirus SARS -CoV-2 is available if the underlying vaccination is with a one or more of the vaccines listed below has been given, and

- a) either consists of the number of vaccine doses published here that are required for a complete vaccination and at least 14 days have passed since the last required individual vaccination, or
- b) consists of a given dose of vaccine to a recovered person.

Proof of complete vaccination protection must be available in German, English, French, Italian or Spanish in embodied or digital form.

TO ENSURE SAFE AND EXPEDITIOUS DELIVERY OF COVID-19 VACCINES, AIRCRAFT OPERATORS OF FLIGHTS CARRYING SUCH VACCINES SHOULD ASK APPROVAL FROM FEDERAL SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY FOR AIR NAVIGATION SERVICES (BAF) FOR EXEMPTION FROM ATFM MEASURES FOR EACH FLIGHT DEEMED CRITICAL. UPON APPROVAL, STS/ATFMX AND RMK/VACCINE SHALL BE INSERTED IN ITEM 18 OF THE FLIGHT PLAN. AIRCRAFT OPERATORS CARRYING COVID 19 VACCINES REGULARLY MAY REQUEST APPROVAL IN ADVANCE FOR ALL FLIGHTS INVOLVED.

COVID-19: PASSENGER RESTRICTIONS

1. RESTRICTIONS

NOTE 1:

TEMPORARY TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS APPLY TO ALL NON-ESSENTIAL TRAVEL FROM THIRD COUNTRIES TO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY.



DUE TO UK'S WITHDRAWAL FROM THE EU, UK IS CONSIDERED A THIRD COUNTRY.  
THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE FLIGHT RESTRICTIONS.

NOTE 2:

THE RESTRICTIONS DO NOT APPLY TO GERMAN CITIZENS.

NOTE 3:

EXEMPTED FROM THESE TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS ARE TRAVELLERS WHO HAVE RESIDED AND LAST STAYED IN THE FOLLOWING COUNTRIES: AUSTRALIA, ISRAEL, JAPAN, NEW ZEELAND, SINGAPORE, SOUTH KOREA, THAILAND.

NOTE 4:

EXTENDED ENTRY POSSIBILITIES WILL BE GIVEN TO TRAVELLERS FROM ALL THIRD COUNTRIES WHO HAVE AN IMPERATIVE NEED FOR TRAVEL:

1. EU CITIZENS AND THIRD-COUNTRY NATIONALS WITH CURRENT RIGHT OF RESIDENCE IN GERMANY,
2. HEALTHCARE WORKERS, HEALTH RESEARCHERS AND GERIATRIC CARE WORKERS,
3. SKILLED AND HIGHLY QUALIFIED FOREIGN WORKERS IF THEIR EMPLOYMENT IS NECESSARY FROM AN ECONOMIC PERSPECTIVE AND THE WORK CANNOT BE POSTPONED OR PERFORMED ABROAD,
4. FREIGHT TRANSPORT AND OTHER TRANSPORT PERSONNEL,
5. SEASONAL WORKERS IN AGRICULTURE,
6. SEAFARERS,
7. FOREIGN STUDENTS, TRAINEES, VOLUNTEERS,
8. PERSONS IMMIGRATING INTO GERMANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF JOINING THEIR FAMILIES AND VISITS FOR URGENT FAMILY REASONS OR SHORT TERM VISITS OF CORE FAMILY MEMBERS (HUSBAND/WIFE, MINOR CHILDREN, PARENTS OF MINOR CHILDREN) OR UNMARRIED PARTNERS IN A RELATIONSHIP WITH GERMAN NATIONALS, EU CITIZENS AND THIRD-COUNTRY NATIONALS WITH CURRENT RIGHT OF RESIDENCE IN GERMANY OR JOINT SHORT TERM VISITS OF COUPLES (THIRD COUNTRY NATIONAL AND GERMAN NATIONAL/EU CITIZEN) RESIDING TOGETHER IN A THIRD COUNTRY FOR IMPORTANT REASONS,
9. PERSONS IN NEED OF INTERNATIONAL PROTECTION OR FOR OTHER HUMANITARIAN REASONS,
10. DIPLOMATS, STAFF OF INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS, MILITARY PERSONNEL AND HUMANITARIAN AID WORKERS IN THE EXERCISE OF THEIR FUNCTIONS,
11. ETHNIC GERMAN RESETTLERS,
12. PASSENGERS IN TRANSIT.

NOTE 5:

ENTRY FROM THIRD COUNTRIES INTO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF ONWARD TRAVEL TO ANOTHER EU-/SCHENGEN STATE IS



PERMITTED.

THIS APPLIES UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. THE TIME SPENT IN GERMANY IS LIMITED TO THE DURATION REQUIRED FOR DIRECT TRANSIT TO THE DESTINATION STATE.
2. THE THIRD-COUNTRY NATIONAL IS PERMITTED TO ENTER THE DESTINATION STATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANNEX I OR ANNEX II OF THE COUNCIL RECOMMENDATION (EU) 2020/912 OF 30 JUNE 2020 OR AN INDIVIDUAL CONFIRMATION OF THE GRANTING OF ENTRY ISSUED BY THE DESTINATION STATE.
3. THIS DOES NOT APPLY IF THE THIRD COUNTRY IS DESIGNATED AS AN AREA OF VARIANTS OF CONCERN (VOC).

UNDER THESE CONDITIONS, ENTRY BY AIR AND ONWARD TRAVEL TO THE COUNTRY OF DESTINATION BY LAND IS ALSO PERMITTED.

IT IS THE TRAVELLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO PROVE THE RIGHT OF ENTRY INTO THE COUNTRY OF DESTINATION AND THE ROUTE OF TRAVEL IN THE EVENT OF CONTROLS.

NOTE 6:

#### 1. REQUIREMENTS

NOTE 1:

CARRIERS MUST PROVIDE INFORMATION OF THE GERMAN FEDERAL MINISTRY OF HEALTH TO ALL PAX.

NOTE 2:

PLEASE ADVISE PAX TO CHECK TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS, TESTING AND QUARANTINE OBLIGATIONS PRIOR TO DEPARTURE.

NOTE 3:

ON ALL FLIGHTS TO GERMANY PAX MUST PRESENT PROOF OF NEGATIVE TEST FOR SARS-COV-2 OR A VACCINATION CERTIFICATE OR A PROOF OF RECOVERY



OF SARS-COV-2 BEFORE DEPARTURE TO THE CARRIER. PAX TRANSITING VIA A GERMAN AIRPORT TO A THIRD COUNTRY ARE EXEMPTED.

PAX WHO HAVE STAYED IN AN AREA OF VARIANTS OF CONCERN (VOC) DURING THE LAST 10 DAYS BEFORE ENTRY MUST PRESENT PROOF OF NEGATIVE TEST FOR SARS-COV-2. A VACCINATION CERTIFICATE OR A PROOF OF RECOVERY OF SARS-COV-2 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

NOTE 4:

THE FOLLOWING TESTS ARE ACCEPTED:

1. NON RISK AREA, INTERNATIONAL RISK AREA INCLUDING A HIGH-INCIDENCE AREA:

1A.: ANTIGEN, THE SAMPLE COLLECTION FOR THE TEST MUST NOT BE OLDER THAN 48HRS BEFORE ENTRY.

1B.: PCR OR POC-PCR TEST, THE SAMPLE COLLECTION FOR THE TEST MUST NOT BE OLDER THAN 72HRS BEFORE ENTRY.

2. AREA OF VARIANTS OF CONCERN

2A.: ANTIGEN, THE SAMPLE COLLECTION FOR THE TEST MUST NOT BE OLDER THAN 24HRS BEFORE ENTRY.

2B.: PCR OR POC-PCR TEST, THE SAMPLE COLLECTION FOR THE TEST MUST NOT BE OLDER THAN 72HRS BEFORE ENTRY.

NOTE 5:

ON ALL FLIGHTS TO GERMANY CARRIERS MUST ONLY TRANSPORT PAX WHO HAVE PRESENTED PROOF OF NEGATIVE TEST FOR SARS-COV-2 OR A VACCINATION CERTIFICATE OR A PROOF OF RECOVERY OF SARS-COV-2.

PAX TRANSITING VIA A GERMAN AIRPORT TO A THIRD COUNTRY ARE EXEMPTED. FURTHER EXEMPTIONS MAY APPLY. PLEASE CHECK AGAINST REGULATION.

NOTE 6:

MANDATORY SARS-COV-2 TESTING DOES NOT APPLY FOR CHILDREN YOUNGER THAN SIX YEARS.

NOTE 7:

A PROOF OF NEGATIVE TEST FOR SARS-COV-2 OR VACCINATION CERTIFICATE OR A PROOF OF RECOVERY OF SARS-COV-2 IS SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL CHECKS BY THE FEDERAL POLICE / COMPETENT AUTHORITY AT DESTINATION AIRPORT IN GERMANY.

NOTE 8:

DESIGNATION OF INTERNATIONAL RISK AREAS, HIGH-INCIDENCE AREAS OR AREAS OF VOC: CARRIERS ARE STRONGLY ADVISED TO REGULARLY REVIEW THE DESIGNATION LIST AT [WWW.RKI.DE/COVID-19-RISIKOGEBIETE](http://WWW.RKI.DE/COVID-19-RISIKOGEBIETE). DESIGNATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT SHORT NOTICE.

NOTE 9:

ENTRY REGISTRATION:





PAX WHO INTEND TO ENTER GERMANY AND WHO HAVE STAYED IN AN INTERNATIONAL RISK AREA INCLUDING A HIGH-INCIDENCE AREA OR AN AREA OF VOC WITHIN THE LAST 10 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY MUST REGISTER ELECTRONICALLY.

PAX TRANSITING VIA A GERMAN AIRPORT TO A THIRD COUNTRY OR A COUNTRY IN THE SCHENGEN AREA ARE EXEMPTED. FURTHER EXEMPTIONS APPLY. PLEASE CHECK AGAINST REGULATION.

USE OF DIGITAL ONLINE PROCEDURE IS STRONGLY ADVISED. PAPER-BASED REGISTRATION IS ONLY ACCEPTED AS A REPLACEMENT IF ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION IS OUT OF ORDER OR PAX DO NOT HAVE ACCESS TO ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION. OFFICIAL SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION FORM MUST BE USED.

NOTE 10:

PROOF OF SUCCESSFUL ENTRY REGISTRATION OR SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION FORM MUST BE KEPT BY PAX AT ALL TIMES AND PRESENTED ON REQUEST TO THE CARRIER OR THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY.

NOTE 11:

PAX RECEIPT OF SUCCESSFUL ENTRY REGISTRATION OR SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION FORM MUST BE CHECKED BY CARRIERS AGAINST ID CARD OR EQUIVALENT PRIOR BOARDING.

CARRIERS MUST ONLY TRANSPORT PAX WHO HAVE PRESENTED PROOF OF SUCCESSFUL REGISTRATION OR SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION FORM. IF THE DATA PROVIDED IS OBVIOUSLY INCORRECT, CARRIERS ARE PROHIBITED TO TRANSPORT PAX.

NOTE 12:

ON FLIGHTS FROM SCHENGEN COUNTRIES TO GERMANY SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION FORM MUST BE COLLECTED BY THE AIRCRAFT CREW AND HANDED OVER TO THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY AT THE DESTINATION AIRPORT IN GERMANY. ON FLIGHTS FROM NON-SCHENGEN COUNTRIES TO GERMANY SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION MUST BE KEPT BY PAX AND HANDED OVER TO THE FEDERAL POLICE / COMPETENT AUTHORITY AT THE DESTINATION AIRPORT IN GERMANY DURING BORDER CONTROL CHECKS.

NOTE 13:

FLIGHTS FROM NON-SCHENGEN COUNTRIES TO GERMANY: REGISTRATION RECEIPT AND SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION IS SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL CHECKS BY THE FEDERAL POLICE / COMPETENT AUTHORITY AT DESTINATION AIRPORT IN GERMANY.

NOTE 14:

CARRIERS ARE PROHIBITED TO TRANSPORT PAX FROM AN AREA OF VOC TO GERMANY. THIS RESTRICTION APPLIES TO ALL TRAVEL OF PAX ORIGINATING FROM AN AREA OF VOC.



EXEMPTIONS: THE TRANSPORT BAN DOES NOT APPLY TO

- PAX HAVING GERMAN NATIONALITY AND PAX RESIDING AND WITH RIGHT OF RESIDENCE IN GERMANY AS WELL AS THEIR SPOUSES, PARTNERS FROM THE SAME HOUSEHOLD AND MINOR CHILDREN.
- PAX TRANSITING A GERMAN AIRPORT,
- EXCLUSIVELY CARGO OR POSTAL OR FERRY FLIGHTS,
- REPATRIATION OF AIRCRAFTS AND CREWS,
- TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONNEL IN THE INTEREST OF PUBLIC HEALTH,
- AMBULANCE FLIGHTS AND FLIGHTS TRANSPORTING TRANSPLANT ORGANS AND NECESSARY ACCOMPANYING PERSONNEL,
- FLIGHTS FOR URGENT HUMANITARIAN REASONS,
- FLIGHTS ON BEHALF OF THE EURATOM SAFEGUARDS, THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY, THE UNITED NATIONS AND ITS AGENCIES,
- MEMBERS OF A FOREIGN DIPLOMATIC MISSION OR CONSULAR OFFICE AS WELL AS THEIR SPOUSES, PARTNERS FROM THE SAME HOUSEHOLD AND MINOR CHILDREN WHOSE APPOINTMENT AND ARRIVAL HAS BEEN NOTIFIED TO THE FEDERAL FOREIGN OFFICE,
- TRANSPORT OF PERSONS ACCREDITED BY THE RESPECTIVE ORGANISING COMMITTEE FOR THE PREPARATION, PARTICIPATION, IMPLEMENTATION AND FOLLOW-UP OF INTERNATIONAL SPORTING EVENTS.

THREE DAYS IN ADVANCE CARRIERS MUST NOTIFY TO THE FEDERAL POLICE FLIGHTS FROM AN AREA OF VOC TO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY FOR TRANSPORT OF PAX RESIDING AND WITH RIGHT OF RESIDENCE IN GERMANY AND FOR PAX HAVING GERMAN NATIONALITY AS WELL AS THEIR SPOUSES, PARTNERS FROM THE SAME HOUSEHOLD AND MINOR CHILDREN.

NOTE 15:

CREW EXEMPTIONS - ENTRY REGISTRATION:

THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO CREWS STAYING LONGER THAN 72 HOURS IN GERMANY OR AREA OF VOC AND WHO HAVE STAYED IN AN AREA OF VOC DURING THE LAST 10 DAYS BEFORE ENTRY.

NOTE 16:

CREW EXEMPTIONS - TESTING:

CREWS ARE EXEMPTED FROM MANDATORY SARS-COV-2 TESTING. THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO CREWS WHO HAVE STAYED IN A HIGH-INCIDENCE AREA LONGER THAN 72 HOURS OR WHO WILL STAY LONGER THAN 72 HOURS IN GERMANY OR WHO HAVE STAYED IN AN AREA OF VOC DURING THE LAST 10 DAYS



BEFORE ENTRY. CREWS MUST PRESENT PROOF OF A NEGATIVE SARS-COV-2 TEST OR A VACCINATION CERTIFICATE OR A PROOF OF RECOVERY OF SARS-COV-2. CREW EXEMPTIONS - QUARANTINE:

CREWS ENTERING GERMANY AND WHO HAVE STAYED IN AN INTERNATIONAL RISK AREA, HIGH-INCIDENCE AREA OR AREA OF VOC DURING THE LAST 10 DAYS BEFORE ENTRY ARE EXEMPTED FROM MANDATORY QUARANTINE.

THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO CREWS STAYING LONGER THAN 72 HOURS IN GERMANY OR AREA OF VOC AND WHO HAVE STAYED IN AN AREA OF VOC DURING THE LAST 10 DAYS BEFORE ENTRY.

NOTE 18:

PAX TRAVELLING AS PART OF AN OFFICIAL GERMAN DELEGATION VIA THE GOVERNMENT TERMINAL OF BER OR VIA CGN AND HAVING STAYED LESS THAN 72H IN AN INTERNATIONAL RISK AREA, HIGH RISK AREA OR AREA OF VOC ARE EXEMPTED FROM ENTRY REGISTRATION AND PRESENTING A PROOF OF NEGATIVE TEST FOR SARS-COV-2 OR A VACCINATION CERTIFICATE OR A PROOF OF RECOVERY OF SARS-COV-2.

NOTE 19:

PAX TRAVELLING PROFESSIONALLY IN ORDER TO TRANSPORT GOODS (ESP. MEDICAL SUPPLY) ARE EXEMPTED FROM ENTRY REGISTRATION AND PRESENTING A PROOF OF NEGATIVE TEST FOR SARS-COV-2 OR A VACCINATION CERTIFICATE OR A PROOF OF RECOVERY OF SARS-COV-2.

NOTE 20:

CARRIERS MUST NAME A SINGLE POINT OF CONTACT (SPC) FOR INFORMATION REQUESTS FROM THE HEALTH AUTHORITIES. THE CONTACT DETAILS OF THE SPC MUST BE COMMUNICATED TO OEGD-KONTAKT(AT)RKI.DE.

NOTE 21:

CARRIERS MUST KEEP THE ELECTRONICALLY STORED BOOKING DATA OF PAX FOR FLIGHTS FROM AN INTERNATIONAL RISK AREA, HIGH RISK AREA OR AREA OF VOC TO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AVAILABLE FOR 30 DAYS AFTER THE ARRIVAL AND PROVIDE THEM TO THE HEALTH AUTHORITIES ON REQUEST. THIS APPLIES, IN PARTICULAR, TO ELECTRONICALLY STORED DATA FOR IDENTIFICATION AND CONTACT DETAILS OF TRAVELLERS AS WELL AS TO SEATING PLANS.

NOTE 22:

THE CREW OF AN EN-ROUTE AIRCRAFT MUST INFORM UPON IDENTIFYING A



SUSPECTED CASE OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASE OR OTHER PUBLIC HEALTH RISK ON BOARD THE AIRCRAFT PROMPTLY THE DESTINATION AIRPORT ACCORDING TO ICAO PANS ATM DOC 4444.

NOTE 23:

NON-COMPLIANCE IS AN ADMINISTRATIVE OFFENCE AND SUBJECT TO PENALTIES.
