Complete and send appointment sheet at least 24 hours before requested appointment. 2. Send to the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Follow up with call to CBP. <p>U.S. CBP Pre-clearance service for Animals</p> <p>The only animals eligible to be pre-cleared are pet dogs, cats, and birds originating from Ireland. They must be accompanied by a health certificate that includes rabies vaccination information and be free of sickness or other anomalies.</p> <p>Passengers with live birds must have a completed Veterinary Services (VS) permit and must have scheduled an inspection of the bird by Veterinary Services at the port of destination. The permit, VS Form 17-135, must accompany the bird at time of inspection.</p>

<p>Customs Information</p>	<p>Sep 17 2020 12:00 UTC</p>	<p>Extended U.S. CBP Pre-clearance service for Private & Charter Aircrafts</p> <p>U.S. CBP has implemented an out-of-hour's preclearance service at Shannon Airport, Ireland, as of September 17, 2020. This program includes inspections of all travelers, their personal articles, and the examination of aircraft. All laws and regulations for entering the United States apply. The United States-Ireland Preclearance Agreement does not provide for the pre-clearance of public aircraft or cargo.</p> <p>US Pre-clearance in Shannon Airport operates from 9AM-5PM; and, EINN will extend these hours to customers when required. The extended hours of operation will be available between the hours of 07:00-09:00 and 17:00-21:00 locally.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o The current charge for normal hours of operation is €150 o The current charge for use of overtime is €945 per flight up to 20 passengers <p>CBP Operating hours for Private & Charter aircrafts at Shannon Airport:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Sunday-Friday between 7AM-7PM (local time). Last requests for service will be accepted at 6PM. o Saturday between 7AM-3PM. Last requests for service will be accepted at 2PM. <p>Private Aircraft Pre-clearance: CBP will process flights that qualify as Private aircrafts under 19 CFR 122.1(h). Private aircraft pilots or representatives must request services no later than 24 hours in advance of the intended inspection start time; and, prior to the close of local CBP business hours the previous day.</p> <p>Charter Aircraft Pre-clearance: Non-scheduled commercial pilots or representatives must request services not later than 48 hours of the inspection start time; and, approval will be on a case-by-case basis.</p> <p>Private Pilots, Non-Scheduled Commercial Carriers, and/or Representatives must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Request for pre-clearance service approval: 24 hours in advance for private; 48 hours in advance for charters; 2. Have a valid user fee decal for the aircraft (unless isn't required); 3. Comply with USDA requirements for handling of regulated garbage at the U.S. destination airport; 4. Submit an electronic manifest (APIS) no later than 60 minutes prior to inspection start time; 5. Present travelers, all baggage, and aircraft for inspection in the CBP facility; 6. Ensure servicing of the aircraft is conducted prior to its physical CBP inspection; 7. Immediate departure upon completion of CBP inspection; 8. Compliance with other CBP requirements as indicated.
